- 1 AN ACT Relating to death benefits for school employees; adding a
- 2 new section to chapter 41.32 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.35
- 3 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.40 RCW; creating a new section;
- 4 repealing 1999 c 309 s 718 (uncodified); providing an effective date;
- 5 and declaring an emergency.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that schools are
- 8 not always the havens of safety and learning that they ought to be. In
- 9 recent years, serious violence has erupted at schools both in the state
- 10 of Washington and across the nation.
- 11 (2) The legislature finds that school employees who entered the
- 12 field of education did not choose the profession knowing their lives
- 13 could be at risk by virtue of being on school grounds performing their
- 14 normal duties.
- 15 (3) The legislature recognizes that all school employees, whether
- 16 they are principals and other administrators, teachers, or classified
- 17 employees, have had their lives threatened, have been in harm's way,
- 18 and in some cases have been killed due to working with students who

- 1 possess firearms and due to other dangerous circumstances and 2 conditions.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 41.32 RCW under the subchapter heading "provisions applicable to plan 1, plan 2, and plan 3" to read as follows:
- (1) A one hundred fifty thousand dollar death benefit shall be paid 6 7 to the estate, as provided in subsection (2) of this section, of a member of any plan under this chapter who is an employee in the common 8 9 school system of the state and who is killed in the course of employment. The determination of eligibility for the benefit shall be 10 made consistent with Title 51 RCW by the department of labor and 11 12 industries. The department of labor and industries shall notify the department of retirement systems by order under RCW 51.52.050. 13

- (1) A one hundred fifty thousand dollar death benefit shall be paid 26 to the estate, as provided in subsection (2) of this section, of a 27 28 member of any plan under this chapter who is an employee in the common school system of the state and who is killed in the course of 29 employment. - 29 or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public
- 30 institutions, and take effect immediately.
- 31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Section 3 of this act takes effect September
- 32 1, 2000.
