- 1 AN ACT Relating to the exercise of stock options; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 50.04 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 50.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 For the purpose of paying contributions in tax rate years beginning
- 8 on or after January 1, 2000, and for the purpose of paying benefits to
- 9 claimants with base years beginning on or after January 1, 2000, the
- 10 term "wages" does not include an employee's income from the transfer of
- 11 shares of stock to the employee pursuant to his or her exercise of a
- 12 stock option granted for any reason connected with his or her
- 13 employment in a disqualifying disposition under section 421 of the
- 14 federal internal revenue code.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any part of this act is found to be in
- 16 conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to
- 17 the allocation of federal funds to the state or the eligibility of
- 18 employers in this state for federal unemployment tax credits, the

- l conflicting part of this act is inoperative solely to the extent of the
- 2 conflict, and the finding or determination does not affect the
- 3 operation of the remainder of this act. Rules adopted under this act
- 4 must meet federal requirements that are a necessary condition to the
- 5 receipt of federal funds by the state or the granting of federal
- 6 unemployment tax credits to employers in this state.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 9 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 10 immediately.
