- 1 AN ACT Relating to the distribution of atypical antipsychotic

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The department of social and health
- 5 services shall create a pilot program to provide atypical antipsychotic
- 6 medications to the following underserved populations who meet one or
- 7 more of these qualifications:
- 8 (a) Persons in crisis who are not medicaid eligible;
- 9 (b) Working poor under two hundred percent of the federal poverty
- 10 level and who are not medicaid eligible and need continued access to
- 11 antipsychotic medications;
- 12 (c) Persons transitioning from jail and from department of
- 13 corrections facilities to medicaid eligibility; and
- 14 (d) Persons in jail.
- 15 (2) This pilot program shall consist of not less than less than two
- 16 grants awarded to regional support networks.
- 17 (3) To be eligible for a grant under this program, the department
- 18 shall establish a competitive application process specifying the
- 19 population to be served and the reimbursement and distribution

- 1 mechanism to be used. The department shall evaluate the applications 2 and award grants based on programs that optimize the number of 3 individuals served within available resources.
- 4 (4) Funding for this program shall be used to provide these persons 5 with atypical antipsychotic medications and any associated laboratory 6 testing related to the use of these medications.
- 7 (5) Funding for this grant program is to be separate from the 8 regional support network allocation formula. The department shall 9 report to the legislature on the results of this program by December 1, 10 2001.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of this act is not provided by June 30, 2000, in the omnibus appropriations act, this act is null and void.
