- 7 postconviction probation or supervision of persons charged with or
- 8 convicted of misdemeanors is necessary to improve the safety of the
- 9 community in general. Also, the legislature finds that the decision
- 10 concerning whether a criminal offender is released into the community
- 11 pending trial or placed on postconviction supervision, as well as
- 12 revocation of community placement, rests with the judiciary.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 9.95 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 If a county, city, or other local government entity engages in the
- 16 provision of preconviction or postconviction probation or supervision
- 17 services for persons charged with or convicted of misdemeanors, the
- 18 county, city, or other local government entity, and their staff and

- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 9.95 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The Washington state law and justice advisory council, appointed
- 8 under RCW 72.09.300(7), shall by October 1, 2000, develop standards for
- 9 preconviction and postconviction probation and supervision services by
- 10 counties, cities, and other local government entities of persons
- 11 charged with or convicted of misdemeanors.
