- AN ACT Relating to denying service credit for certain members of the state retirement system; adding a new section to chapter 41.26 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.32 RCW; adding a new section to

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the citizens of
- 8 Washington state expect government employees to obey the law and to
- 9 have the requisite character necessary to perform public service in an
- 10 ethical manner. The legislature further finds that taxpayers should
- 11 not be forced to continue to subsidize the retirement programs of
- 12 public employees who are convicted of felony criminal acts.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 41.26 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 Whenever a member has been convicted of a felony related to the
- 16 member's duties in his or her eligible position, service credit shall
