- 1 AN ACT Relating to tuition waivers for students who provide
- 2 services to fellow disabled students; amending RCW 28B.15.910; and
- 3 adding a new section to chapter 28B.15 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.15 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The governing boards of the state universities, the regional
- 8 universities, The Evergreen State College, and the community colleges
- 9 may waive all or a portion of the tuition for undergraduate or graduate
- 10 students who are employed or contracted by the institutions to provide
- 11 services to fellow students who are disabled under the federal
- 12 Americans with disabilities act of 1990. The type of services provided
- 13 may include, but is not limited to, sign language interpreting,
- 14 tutoring, reading, and note taking.
- The waiver in this section is not subject to the limitations of RCW
- 16 28B.15.910.
- 17 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.15.910 and 1999 c 344 s 3 are each amended to read

(1) Except for revenue waived under programs listed in subsections 1 (3) and (4) of this section, and unless otherwise expressly provided in 2 3 the omnibus state appropriations act, the total amount of operating 4 fees revenue waived, exempted, or reduced by a state university, a regional university, The Evergreen State College, or the community 5 colleges as a whole, shall not exceed the percentage of total gross 6 authorized operating fees revenue in this subsection. As used in this 7 8 section, "gross authorized operating fees revenue" means the estimated 9 gross operating fees revenue as estimated under RCW 82.33.020 or as 10 revised by the office of financial management, before granting any This limitation applies to all tuition waiver programs 11 established before or after July 1, 1992. 12
