- 6 $\underline{\text{(1)}}$ Not less than thirty days before the first day for filing
- declarations of candidacy under RCW 29.15.020 for legislative,
- 8 judicial, county, city, town, or district office, where more than one
- 9 position with the same name, district number, or title will be voted

- The positions so designated shall be dealt with as separate offices

- The name of a candidate for a partisan office for which a primary was conducted shall not be printed on the ballot for that office at the subsequent general election unless the candidate receives a number of votes equal to at least <u>one-half of</u> one percent of the total number cast for all candidates for that position sought and a plurality of the votes cast for the candidates of his or her party for that office at the preceding primary.
