- 1 AN ACT Relating to delegation of authority for water well tagging,
- 2 sealing, and decommissioning; amending RCW 18.104.043; amending 1996 c
- 3 12 s 1 (uncodified); and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** 1996 c 12 s 1 (uncodified) is amended to read as follows:
- 6 The legislature finds that experimental delegation of portions of
- 7 the well drilling administration and enforcement authority of the
- 8 department of ecology to willing and able local governments has been
- 9 successful to date. Delegation has provided a more effective and
- 10 efficient means of assuring proper well construction and
- 11 decommissioning and protection of public health and safety than could
- 12 be accomplished by the department of ecology acting alone. The
- 13 legislature further finds that without legislative action, the
- 14 authority for such delegation will expire June 30, 1996. Therefore, it
- 15 is the intent of the legislature to ((extend the authority for))
- 16 <u>permanently authorize</u> delegation ((an additional four years)).
- 17 Sec. 2. RCW 18.104.043 and 1996 c 12 s 2 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:

p. 1 HB 2997

1 (1) If requested in writing by the governing body of a local health 2 district or county, the department by memorandum of agreement may 3 delegate to the governing body the authority to administer and enforce 4 the well tagging, sealing, and decommissioning portions of the water 5 well construction program.

- (2) The department shall determine whether a local health district or county that seeks delegation under this section has the resources, capability, and expertise, including qualified field inspectors, to administer the delegated program. If the department determines the local government has these resources, it shall notify well contractors, consultants, and operators of the proposal. The department shall accept written comments on the proposal for sixty days after the notice is mailed.
- (3) If the department determines that a delegation of authority to 14 15 a local health district or county to administer and enforce the well 16 sealing and decommissioning portions of the water well construction 17 program will enhance the public health and safety and the environment, the department and the local governing body may enter into a memorandum 18 19 of agreement setting forth the specific authorities delegated by the 20 department to the local governing body. The memorandum of agreement shall provide for an initial review of the delegation within one year 21 22 and for periodic review thereafter.
 - (4) With regard to the portions of the water well construction program delegated under this section, the local governing agency shall exercise only the authority delegated to it under this section. If, after a public hearing, the department determines that a local governing body is not administering the program in accordance with this chapter, it shall notify the local governing body of the deficiencies. If corrective action is not taken within a reasonable time, not to exceed sixty days, the department by order shall withdraw the delegation of authority.
- 32 (5) The department shall promptly furnish the local governing body 33 with a copy of each water well report and notification of start cards 34 received in the area covered by a delegated program.
- 35 (6) The department and the local governing body shall coordinate to 36 reduce duplication of effort and shall share all appropriate 37 information including technical reports, violations, and well reports.
- 38 (7) Any person aggrieved by a decision of a local health district 39 or county under a delegated program may appeal the decision to the

- 1 department. The department's decision is subject to review by the 2 pollution control hearings board as provided in RCW 43.21B.110.
- 3 (8) The department shall not delegate the authority to license well 4 contractors, renew licenses, receive notices of intent to commence 5 constructing a well, receive well reports, or collect state fees 6 provided for in this chapter.
- 7 ((9) This section expires June 30, 2000.)
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate 9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect 11 immediately.
