1 AN ACT Relating to local government funding assistance; adding new
2 sections to 1999 c 309 (uncodified); making appropriations; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to 1999 c 309
6 (uncodified) to read as follows:

7 **FOR THE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT--MUNICIPAL FIRE AND POLICE**
8 **PROTECTION**

9 It is the intent of the legislature to continue to support a
10 portion of the ongoing costs for these cities for programs and services
11 through future appropriations. For the purpose of municipal fire and
12 police protection, subject to section 7 of this act, the following
13 amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the office of
14 financial management for distribution to the following cities in the
15 amounts designated:
