1 AN ACT Relating to annexations by less than county-wide port  
2 districts in areas having no registered voters; and amending RCW  
3 53.04.150.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 53.04.150 and 1999 c 250 s 2 are each amended to read  
6 as follows:

7 A port district that is less than county-wide, and that is located  
8 in a county with a population of less than ninety thousand and located  
9 in either the Interstate 5 or Interstate 90 corridor, may petition for  
10 annexation of an area that is contiguous to its boundaries, is not  
11 located within the boundaries of any other port district, and contains  
12 no registered voters. The petition must be in writing, addressed to  
13 and filed with the port commission, and signed by the owners of not  
14 less than seventy-five percent of the property value in the area to be  
15 annexed, according to the assessed value for general taxation. The  
16 petition must contain a legal description of the property according to  
17 government legal subdivisions or legal plats, or a sufficient metes and

- 1 bounds description, and must be accompanied by a plat outlining the
- 2 boundaries of the property to be annexed.
