- 1 AN ACT Relating to making community service a graduation
- 2 requirement in Washington state schools; adding new sections to chapter
- 3 28A.150 RCW; creating new sections; and providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** This act may be known and cited as the
- 6 community service act of 2000.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) The legislature finds that:
- 8 (a) Young people were four times more likely to volunteer if they
- 9 were asked than if they were not asked;
- 10 (b) In Snohomish county, more than one hundred fifty thousand
- 11 volunteers, about half the county population, log more than two million
- 12 five hundred thousand hours each year. That is equivalent to more than
- 13 thirty-three million dollars in paid staff hours, including benefits;
- 14 (c) A lot of colleges require community service on their
- 15 applications;
- 16 (d) People learn things they are good at, and that helps them
- 17 decide what they want to do as a career and also gives them valuable
- 18 skills that they will use forever; and

- 1 (e) Community service gives students responsibility and allows them
- 2 to prove that they can make a difference in the community.
- 3 (2) The purposes of this act are:
- 4 (a) To get students involved in their community; and
- 5 (b) To get students ready for the profession in which they are
- 6 interested.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** (1) All students in Washington state high
- 8 schools shall complete a minimum of forty hours of community service.
- 9 (2) The superintendent of public instruction shall adopt rules to
- 10 implement this section and establish a process for a school board to
- 11 exempt a student from the requirement under this section.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** The definitions in this section apply
- 13 throughout sections 1 through 3 of this act unless the context clearly
- 14 requires otherwise.
- 15 (1) "Community service" means activities that are noncurriculum-
- 16 based and nonprofit and are recognized or arranged through the school.
- 17 (2) "Volunteer" means doing work without any payment.
- 18 (3) "Students" means people who are in the ninth grade through the
- 19 twelfth grade and are enrolled in high school.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** (1) This act applies to all federal and
- 21 state law, and the implementation of that law, whether statutory or
- 22 otherwise, and whether adopted before or after the effective date of
- 23 this act.
- 24 (2) State statutory law adopted after the effective date of this
- 25 act is subject to this act unless such law explicitly excludes such
- 26 application by reference to this act.
- 27 <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **Sec. 6.** Nothing in this act shall be construed to
- 28 affect, interpret, or in any way change the Constitution of the United
- 29 States or the Constitution of the state of Washington.
- 30 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** This act takes effect August 1, 2001.
