## HOUSE BILL 3108

State of Washington 56th Legislature 2000 Regular Session

By Representatives Pennington, Barlean, Esser, Ericksen and Cairnes

Read first time 02/01/2000. Referred to Committee on Appropriations.

- AN ACT Relating to providing adequate revenues for the support of state parks; amending RCW 79A.05.215 and 82.08.020; creating a new section; providing an effective date; and providing for submission of this act to a vote of the people.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature recognizes the need to secure an adequate revenue base for the operation, maintenance, and 7 8 improvement of the state parks system. It is the intent of the 9 legislature, by dedicating a portion of the general revenues of the 10 state to state parks, to provide sufficient revenues for state parks to of the state parks 11 meet the needs operating, capital, transportation budget appropriations previously met directly by the 12 13 general revenues of the state of Washington, including general 14 transportation revenues and capital bond moneys supported by the 15 general fund.
- 16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 79A.05.215 and 1995 c 211 s 7 are each amended to read 17 as follows:

p. 1 HB 3108

- 1 The state parks renewal and stewardship account is created in the
- 2 state treasury. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, all
- 3 receipts from user fees, concessions, leases, and other state park-
- 4 based activities, and all revenues derived under RCW 82.08.020(3),
- 5 shall be deposited into the account. Expenditures from the account may
- 6 be used for <u>only</u> operating state parks, developing and renovating park
- 7 facilities, undertaking deferred maintenance, <u>making capital</u>
- 8 investments in the state parks, maintaining state parks roads,
- 9 enhancing park stewardship, and other state park purposes
- 10 Expenditures from the account may be made only after appropriation by
- 11 the legislature.
- 12 **Sec. 3.** RCW 82.08.020 and 1998 c 321 s 36 (Referendum Bill No. 49)
- 13 are each amended to read as follows:
- 14 (1) There is levied and there shall be collected a tax on each
- 15 retail sale in this state equal to six and five-tenths percent of the
- 16 selling price.
- 17 (2) There is levied and there shall be collected an additional tax
- 18 on each retail car rental, regardless of whether the vehicle is
- 19 licensed in this state, equal to five and nine-tenths percent of the
- 20 selling price. The revenue collected under this subsection shall be
- 21 deposited and distributed in the same manner as motor vehicle excise
- 22 tax revenue collected under RCW 82.44.020(1).
- 23 (3) There is levied and there shall be collected a tax on each
- 24 retail sale in this state equal to one-tenth percent of the selling
- 25 price. The tax shall be credited against the tax imposed under
- 26 <u>subsection (1) of this section. The revenue collected under this</u>
- 27 subsection shall be deposited in the parks renewal and stewardship
- 28 account.
- 29 (4) The taxes imposed under this chapter shall apply to successive
- 30 retail sales of the same property.
- 31 (((4))) (5) The rates provided in this section apply to taxes
- 32 imposed under chapter 82.12 RCW as provided in RCW 82.12.020.
- 33 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act takes effect July 1, 2001.
- 34 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** The secretary of state shall submit this act
- 35 to the people for their adoption and ratification, or rejection, at the
- 36 next general election to be held in this state, in accordance with

- 1 Article II, section 1 of the state Constitution and the laws adopted to
- 2 facilitate its operation.
