- 1 AN ACT Relating to revenue sources for transportation purposes;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 43.79 RCW; adding a new section to

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.79 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The transportation progress account is created in the state
- 9 treasury. Moneys in the account may be spent only after appropriation.
- 10 Expenditures from the account may be used only for transportation
- 11 purposes.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.32 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (1) Ten and twenty-five one-hundredths percent of automobile-
- 15 related sales and use tax revenue shall be deposited in the
- 16 transportation progress account under section 1 of this act.

- 1 (2) Two and forty-five one-hundredths percent of automobile-related 2 sales and use tax revenue shall be deposited in the Puget Sound ferry 3 operations account under RCW 47.60.530.
- 4 (3) For the purposes of this section, "automobile-related sales and 5 use tax revenue" includes:
- (a) Revenue from the taxes imposed in RCW 82.08.020(1) and 6 7 82.12.020 reported on returns filed by persons engaged in the following 8 businesses: New and used car dealers; automotive parts, accessories, 9 and tire stores; automotive repair services, including body, paint and 10 interior repair and maintenance, exhaust system repair, replacement shops, transmission repair, oil change and lubrication 11 shops, car washes, and other automotive mechanical and electrical 12 repair and maintenance businesses; automobile and other motor vehicle 13 wholesalers, motor vehicle supplies and new part wholesalers, tire and 14
- 16 (b) Revenue from the taxes imposed in RCW 82.08.020(1) and 82.12.020 collected by the department of licensing, county auditors, and subagents for the sale or use of motor vehicles.

tube wholesalers, and motor vehicle used part wholesalers; and

NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect June 1, 2000.
