1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Washington, the Senate concurring, That immediately before adjournment
3 SINE DIE of this 2000 1st Special Session of the Fifty-sixth
4 Legislature:

5 (1) The House of Representatives shall transmit to the Senate all
6 Senate bills, Senate joint resolutions, Senate concurrent resolutions,
7 and Senate joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed
8 by the House of Representatives, and upon receipt by the Senate of such
9 measures they shall be assigned to the Senate Rules Committee for third
10 reading; and

11 (2) The Senate shall transmit to the House of Representatives all
12 House bills, House joint resolutions, House concurrent resolutions, and
13 House joint memorials in its possession that have not been passed by
14 the Senate, and upon receipt by the House of Representatives of such
15 measures they shall be assigned to the House Rules Committee for third
16 reading; and

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Co-Chief Clerks of the House of
18 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate shall retain in their
19 possession and in the status that exists upon the adjournment SINE DIE
20 of the 2000 1st Special Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature, all
21 legislative measures including all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent

1 resolutions, and joint memorials that may at that time be in their
2 respective houses and all records, journals, dockets, and other
3 documents pertaining thereto; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all measures introduced at any
5 subsequent special session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature shall be
6 numbered as a continuation of the numbers assigned to measures of the
7 2000 1st Special Session of the Fifty-sixth Legislature.
