1 AN ACT Relating to the transfer and management of state trust land;
2 adding a new section to chapter 79.08 RCW; and creating a new section.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 79.08 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 Prior to any trade, transfer of management, or sale of five hundred
7 acres or more of state trust land, the board of natural resources shall
8 require the new management entity or owner to provide the following in
9 perpetuity:

- 10 (1) Law enforcement on such lands;
11 (2) Fire protection on such lands;
12 (3) Long-term management plans to the public for review and
13 comment; and
14 (4) Plans and programs to minimize negative local economic and
15 social impacts of the lands' management.

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The board of natural resources and the
17 department of natural resources shall review their authority to trade,
18 sell, or transfer management authority for state trust lands and shall

- 1 report back to the legislature by December 1, 2000, on recommendations
- 2 for changes in or clarifications of law.
