1 AN ACT Relating to catch record card requirements for recreational
2 crab fishers; adding a new section to chapter 77.32 RCW; and creating
3 a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the department of
6 fish and wildlife manages the recreational crab fishery through an
7 imprecise system of catch estimation. Increased harvest data accuracy
8 is needed for the recreational crab fishery and this goal can be
9 accomplished through the establishment of a crab catch record card
10 system.

11 The department shall utilize data from the crab catch record cards
12 in preparing catch reports and in catch-sharing negotiations.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 77.32 RCW
14 to read as follows:

15 In addition to a combination fishing license, saltwater fishing
16 license, temporary fishing license, or a family fishing weekend
17 license, a crab catch record card is required to fish for and harvest
18 Dungeness crabs (*Cancer magister*) in the recreational fishery. The

1 crab catch record card shall be administered under the rules of the
2 commission.

3 The commission shall require that fishers carry their card when
4 fishing for crab, that harvest data be immediately entered onto the
5 card when crab are harvested, and that it be mandatory that the card is
6 returned to the department when it has expired.
