1 AN ACT Relating to use of certain revenues from local taxation of
2 social card games; and amending RCW 9.46.113.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.46.113 and 1975 1st ex.s. c 166 s 11 are each
5 amended to read as follows:

6 Any county, city, or town which collects a tax on gambling
7 activities authorized pursuant to RCW 9.46.110 shall use the revenue
8 from such tax primarily for the purpose of enforcement of the
9 provisions of this chapter by the county, city, or town law enforcement
10 agency. Of that portion of revenue from a tax rate exceeding ten
11 percent of the gross revenues from social card games, seventy-five
12 percent must be used solely to fund streets and roads, and twenty-five
13 percent must be used solely to fund compulsive gambling education and
14 awareness programs.
