1 AN ACT Relating to pedestrian, equestrian, and bicycle pathways;
2 amending RCW 47.30.020; and repealing RCW 47.30.050.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.30.020 and 1971 ex.s. c 130 s 2 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Facilities for pedestrians, equestrians, or bicyclists (~~shall~~)
7 may be incorporated into the design of highways and freeways along
8 corridors where such facilities do not exist upon a finding that such
9 facilities would be of joint use and conform to the comprehensive plans
10 of public agencies for the development of such facilities, will not
11 duplicate existing or proposed routes, and that safety to both
12 motorists and to pedestrians, equestrians, and bicyclists would be
13 enhanced by the segregation of traffic.

14 (~~In planning and design of all highways, every effort shall be~~
15 ~~made consistent with safety to promote joint usage of rights of way for~~
16 ~~trails and paths in accordance with the comprehensive plans of public~~
17 ~~agencies.~~)

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** RCW 47.30.050 (Expenditures for paths and
2 trails--Minimum amount) and 1999 c 269 s 11, 1979 ex.s. c 121 s 2, &
