- 1 AN ACT Relating to the priority distribution of anatomical gifts;
- 2 amending RCW 68.50.530; and adding new sections to chapter 68.50 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 68.50.530 and 1996 c 178 s 15 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Unless the context requires otherwise, the definitions in this
- 7 section apply throughout RCW 68.50.520 through 68.50.630 and 68.50.901
- 8 through 68.50.904 and sections 2 through 4 of this act.
- 9 (1) "Anatomical gift" means a donation of all or part of a human
- 10 body to take effect upon or after death.
- 11 (2) "Decedent" means a deceased individual.
- 12 (3) "Document of gift" means a card, a statement attached to or
- 13 imprinted on a motor vehicle operator's license, a will, or other
- 14 writing used to make an anatomical gift.
- 15 (4) "Donor" means an individual who makes an anatomical gift of all
- 16 or part of the individual's body.
- 17 (5) "Enucleator" means an individual who is qualified to remove or
- 18 process eyes or parts of eyes.

- 1 (6) "Hospital" means a facility licensed under chapter 70.41 RCW,
- 2 or as a hospital under the law of any state or a facility operated as
- 3 a hospital by the United States government, a state, or a subdivision
- 4 of a state.
- 5 (7) "Part" means an organ, tissue, eye, bone, artery, blood, fluid,
- 6 or other portion of a human body.
- 7 (8) "Person" means an individual, corporation, business trust,
- 8 estate, trust, partnership, joint venture, association, government,
- 9 governmental subdivision or agency, or any other legal or commercial
- 10 entity.
- 11 (9) "Physician" or "surgeon" means an individual licensed or
- 12 otherwise authorized to practice medicine and surgery or osteopathic
- 13 medicine and surgery under chapters 18.71 and 18.57 RCW.
- 14 (10) "Priority distribution" means the donor's determination that
- 15 his or her organs shall first be distributed to a transplant program
- 16 <u>located within the state of Washington.</u>
- 17 <u>(11)</u> "Procurement organization" means a person licensed,
- 18 accredited, or approved under the laws of any state for procurement,
- 19 distribution, or storage of human bodies or parts.
- 20 $((\frac{11}{11}))$ <u>(12)</u> "State" means a state, territory, or possession of
- 21 the United States, the District of Columbia, or the Commonwealth of
- 22 Puerto Rico.
- $((\frac{12}{12}))$ Technician" means an individual who is qualified to
- 24 remove or process a part.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 68.50 RCW
- 26 to read as follows:
- 27 All documents of gift shall include a provision that permits the
- 28 donor to designate priority distribution.
- 29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 68.50 RCW
- 30 to read as follows:
- 31 Every donor has the absolute right to specify priority distribution
- 32 of his or her organs.
- 33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 68.50 RCW
- 34 to read as follows:
