1 AN ACT Relating to including preapprenticeship programs in the  
2 definition of work activity; and amending RCW 74.08A.250.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.08A.250 and 1997 c 58 s 311 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, as used in this  
7 chapter, "work activity" means:

8 (1) Unsubsidized paid employment in the private or public sector;

9 (2) Subsidized paid employment in the private or public sector;

10 (3) Work experience, including work associated with the  
11 refurbishing of publicly assisted housing, if sufficient paid  
12 employment is not available;

13 (4) On-the-job training;

14 (5) Job search and job readiness assistance;

15 (6) Community service programs;

16 (7) Vocational educational training, not to exceed twelve months  
17 with respect to any individual;

18 (8) Job skills training directly related to employment;

19 (9) Enrollment in a preapprenticeship training program;

1        (10) Education directly related to employment, in the case of a  
2 recipient who has not received a high school diploma or a GED;  
3        (~~(10)~~) (11) Satisfactory attendance at secondary school or in a  
4 course of study leading to a GED, in the case of a recipient who has  
5 not completed secondary school or received such a certificate;  
6        (~~(11)~~) (12) The provision of child care services to an individual  
7 who is participating in a community service program; and  
8        (~~(12)~~) (13) Services required by the recipient under RCW  
9 74.08.025(3) and 74.08A.010(3) to become employable.
