1 AN ACT Relating to civil service exemptions in the department of
2 transportation; and amending RCW 41.06.079.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.06.079 and 1993 c 281 s 23 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 In addition to the exemptions set forth in RCW 41.06.070, the
7 provisions of this chapter shall not apply in the department of
8 transportation to the secretary, ~~((a)) two~~ deputy ~~((secretary, an
9 administrative assistant to the secretary, if any))~~ secretaries, one
10 assistant secretary for each division designated pursuant to RCW
11 47.01.081, one confidential secretary for each of the above-named
12 officers, up to six transportation ~~((district))~~ regional administrators
13 and one confidential secretary for each ~~((district))~~ regional
14 administrator, and up to ~~((six additional new administrators or
15 confidential secretaries))~~ eighteen other positions designated by the
16 secretary of the department of transportation and approved by the
17 Washington personnel resources board ~~((pursuant to the provisions of))~~
18 under RCW 41.06.070~~((1)(z), the legislative liaison for the
19 department, the state construction engineer, the state aid engineer,~~

1 ~~the personnel manager, the state project development engineer, the~~
2 ~~state maintenance and operations engineer, one confidential secretary~~
3 ~~for each of the last named five positions, and a confidential secretary~~
4 ~~for the public affairs administrator)) (3). The individuals appointed~~
5 under this section shall be exempt from the provisions of the state
6 civil service law, and shall be paid salaries to be fixed by the
7 governor in accordance with the procedure established by law for the
8 fixing of salaries for individuals exempt from the operation of the
9 state civil service law.
