1 AN ACT Relating to agency advertisements; and amending RCW
2 43.330.092.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.330.092 and 1997 c 220 s 222 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The film and video promotion account is created in the state
7 treasury. All receipts from RCW 36.102.060(14) must be deposited into
8 the account. Moneys in the account may be spent only after
9 appropriation. Expenditures from the account may be used by the
10 department of community, trade, and economic development only for the
11 purposes of promotion of the film and video production industry in the
12 state of Washington.

13 (2)(a) Any commercial or advertisement that is produced by or on
14 behalf of a state agency, and that uses film, video, or other form of
15 live action media, must be filmed in Washington state.

16 (b) If a state agency determines that it is not possible to comply
17 with (a) of this subsection, then the state agency must receive express

1 written permission from the governor's office prior to filming any form
2 of live action media outside of the state.
