1 AN ACT Relating to creating the education and transportation
2 funding act of 2000; adding a new section to chapter 41.06 RCW; adding
3 a new section to chapter 43.88 RCW; creating a new section; and
4 repealing RCW 41.06.380 and 41.06.382.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** This act may be known and cited as the
7 education and transportation funding act of 2000.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.06 RCW
9 to read as follows:

10 Any department, agency, or institution of higher education may
11 purchase services, including services that have been customarily and
12 historically provided by employees in the classified service under this
13 chapter, by contracting with individuals, nonprofit organizations,
14 businesses, employee business units, or other entities.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 43.88 RCW
16 to read as follows:

1 The office of financial management shall establish a process for
2 identifying the savings achieved by state agencies and institutions of
3 higher education as a result of contracting for services under the
4 authority granted in section 2 of this act. It is the intent of the
5 legislature that, of the initial seven hundred million dollars in
6 identified savings, fifty percent be directed to providing increased
7 state funding for common school basic education programs and fifty
8 percent be directed to providing increased state funding for
9 transportation projects and programs.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** The following acts or parts of acts are each
11 repealed:

12 (1) RCW 41.06.380 (Purchasing services by contract not prohibited--
13 Limitations) and 1979 ex.s. c 46 s 2; and

14 (2) RCW 41.06.382 (Purchasing services by contract not prohibited--
15 Limitations) and 1979 ex.s. c 46 s 1.
