1            BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
2 STATE OF WASHINGTON, IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION ASSEMBLED:

3            THAT, At the next general election to be held in this state the  
4 secretary of state shall submit to the qualified voters of the state  
5 for their approval and ratification, or rejection, an amendment to  
6 Article XXIX, section 1 of the Constitution of the state of Washington  
7 to read as follows:

8            Article XXIX, section 1.      Notwithstanding the provisions of  
9 sections 5, and 7 of Article VIII and section 9 of Article XII or any  
10 other section or article of the Constitution of the state of  
11 Washington, the moneys of any public pension or retirement fund (~~(or)~~),  
12 industrial insurance trust fund, or fund held in trust for the benefit  
13 of persons with developmental disabilities may be invested as  
14 authorized by law.

15            BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the secretary of state shall cause  
16 notice of this constitutional amendment to be published at least four  
17 times during the four weeks next preceding the election in every legal  
18 newspaper in the state.
