Brief Title: Requiring school districts to provide programs for highly capable students.

HB 1815-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Declares an intent to enhance the ability of basic education teachers to address the needs and expectations of highly capable students in public schools.

Declares that the purpose of this act is to increase the achievement of highly capable students by requiring programs for highly capable students in basic education and providing funding for such programs in all school districts in the state.

Requires the biennial omnibus appropriations act to specify a minimum level of funding that shall be provided to small school districts in which the number of students generating funding for programs for highly capable students is too low to adequately support services for highly capable students in those districts.
