Brief Description: Affecting truancy provisions for students who change school districts or move to another county.

HB 1938 - DIGEST

Provides that, if a child transfers from one school district to another, the receiving school or school district shall honor the attendance record including the unexcused absences accumulated at the previous school or from the previous school district.

Provides that, if after a juvenile court assumes jurisdiction in one county the child relocates to another county, the juvenile court in the receiving county shall, upon the request of a school district or parent, assume jurisdiction of the petition filed in the previous county.
