Brief Title: Making any robbery within a financial institution a first degree robbery.

HB 2263-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/16/99)

Declares that a person is guilty of robbery in the first degree if he or she commits a robbery within and against a financial institution as defined in RCW 7.88.010.

Declares that robbery in the first degree is a class A felony.

Provides that the act shall be null and void if appropriations are not approved.
