Brief Title: Improving community and technical colleges' contributions to economic development.

SB 5743-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 3/16/99)

Appoints a committee to examine residency requirements for out-of-state tuition at public institutions of higher education.

Requires the study to include, but not be limited to: (1) The impact the state's rules for in-state and out-of-state tuition setting has on economic development within the state; and

(2) how the state's residency requirements should be applied to enrollment in distance learning courses.

Requires a final report to the senate and house of representatives committees on higher education by December 1, 1999.

Expires December 31, 1999.
