**SB 6020-S.E - DIGEST**

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Delays implementation of the requirement to record social security numbers on license applications to assist in child support enforcement.

Declares that the legislature will require compliance with federal law in this matter only at such time and in the event that the federal government actually implements the requirement of using social security numbers on noncommercial driver's license applications.
