Brief Description: Prohibiting sale of domesticated dog or cat fur without accurate labeling.

SB 6192 - DIGEST

Declares that it is unlawful for any person to sell or place into the stream of commerce the fur of a domestic dog or cat or any product that contains the fur of a domestic dog or cat unless it is accurately labeled as containing the same.
