Brief Description: Ordering a study of law enforcement issues in counties with over 150,000 population.

SB 6369-S2 - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/15/00)

Directs the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs to conduct a study of the total costs and expenditures for law enforcement for both counties and cities within the county for counties with populations over one hundred fifty thousand.

Requires that, in conducting the study the Washington association of sheriffs and police chiefs shall collaborate with the legislative evaluation and accountability program committee and the state auditor's office.
