3 On page 2, after line 22, insert:

4 (3) A person convicted or adjudicated of taking a motor vehicle  
5 without permission in the first degree or taking a motor vehicle  
6 without permission in the second degree under this section shall also  
7 have driving privileges revoked in accordance with RCW 46.20.285. Upon  
8 conviction, the court shall immediately transmit conviction data to the  
9 department of licensing necessary for the administration of RCW  
10 46.20.285.-

11 On page 22, after line 23, insert:

12 **Sec. 5.** RCW 46.20.285 and 2001 c 64 s 6 are each amended to  
13 read as follows:

14 The department shall forthwith revoke the license of any driver  
15 for the period of one calendar year unless otherwise provided in this  
16 section, upon receiving a record of the driver's conviction of any of  
17 the following offenses, when the conviction has become final:

18 (1) For vehicular homicide the period of revocation shall be two  
19 years. The revocation period shall be tolled during any period of  
20 total confinement for the offense;

21 (2) Vehicular assault. The revocation period shall be tolled  
22 during any period of total confinement for the offense;

23 (3) Driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of  
24 intoxicating liquor or a narcotic drug, or under the influence of any  
25 other drug to a degree which renders the driver incapable of safely  
26 driving a motor vehicle, for the period prescribed in RCW 46.61.5055;

27 (4) Any felony in the commission of which a motor vehicle is used;

28 (5) Failure to stop and give information or render aid as required  
29 under the laws of this state in the event of a motor vehicle accident  
30 resulting in the death or personal injury of another or resulting in  
31 damage to a vehicle that is driven or attended by another;

32 (6) Perjury or the making of a false affidavit or statement under  
33 oath to the department under Title 46 RCW or under any other law  
34 relating to the ownership or operation of motor vehicles;

1           (7) Reckless driving upon a showing by the department's records  
2 that the conviction is the third such conviction for the driver within  
3 a period of two years;

4           (8) Taking a motor vehicle without permission in the first degree  
5 or taking a motor vehicle without permission in the second degree."

**EFFECT:** Requires the Department of Licensing to revoke the driver's license of any person convicted of taking a motor vehicle without permission for one year.
