7 "Sec. 1. RCW 28B.10.802 and 1989 c 254 s 2 are each amended to
8 read as follows:

9 As used in RCW 28B.10.800 through 28B.10.824:

10 (1) "Institutions of higher education" shall mean (1) any public
11 university, college, community college, or vocational-technical
12 institute operated by the state of Washington or any political
13 subdivision thereof or (2) any other university, college, school, or
14 institute in the state of Washington offering instruction beyond the
15 high school level which is a member institution of an accrediting
16 association recognized by rule of the board for the purposes of this
17 section: PROVIDED, That any institution, branch, extension or facility
18 operating within the state of Washington which is affiliated with an
19 institution operating in another state must be a separately accredited
20 member institution of any such accrediting association, or a branch of
21 a member institution of an accrediting association recognized by rule
22 of the board for purposes of this section, that is eligible for federal
23 student financial aid assistance and has operated as a nonprofit
24 college or university delivering on-site classroom instruction for a
25 minimum of twenty consecutive years within the state of Washington, and
26 has an annual enrollment of at least seven hundred full-time equivalent
27 students: PROVIDED FURTHER, That no institution of higher education
28 shall be eligible to participate in a student financial aid program
29 unless it agrees to and complies with program rules and regulations
30 adopted pursuant to RCW 28B.10.822.

31 (2) The term "financial aid" shall mean loans and/or grants to
32 needy students enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a student at
33 institutions of higher education.

34 (3) The term "needy student" shall mean a post high school student
35 of an institution of higher learning as defined in subsection (1) of
36 this section who demonstrates to the board the financial inability,

1 either through the student's parents, family and/or personally, to meet
2 the total cost of board, room, books, and tuition and incidental fees
3 for any semester or quarter.

4 (4) The term "disadvantaged student" shall mean a post high school
5 student who by reason of adverse cultural, educational, environmental,
6 experiential, familial or other circumstances is unable to qualify for
7 enrollment as a full time student in an institution of higher learning,
8 who would otherwise qualify as a needy student, and who is attending an
9 institution of higher learning under an established program designed to
10 qualify the student for enrollment as a full time student.

11 (5) "Commission" or "board" shall mean the higher education
12 coordinating board.

13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.12.030 and 1994 c 130 s 3 are each amended to read
14 as follows:

15 As used in this chapter, the following words and terms shall have
16 the following meanings, unless the context shall clearly indicate
17 another or different meaning or intent:

18 (1) The term "needy student" shall mean a student enrolled or
19 accepted for enrollment at a post-secondary institution who, according
20 to a system of need analysis approved by the higher education
21 coordinating board, demonstrates a financial inability, either
22 parental, familial, or personal, to bear the total cost of education
23 for any semester or quarter.

24 (2) The term "eligible institution" shall mean any post-secondary
25 institution in this state accredited by the Northwest Association of
26 Schools and Colleges, or a branch of a member institution of an
27 accrediting association recognized by rule of the board for purposes of
28 this section, that is eligible for federal student financial aid
29 assistance and has operated as a nonprofit college or university
30 delivering on-site classroom instruction for a minimum of twenty
31 consecutive years within the state of Washington, or any public
32 technical college in the state."

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
