- 1 (a) All tangible or intangible property, including any right or 2 interest in such property, acquired by a person convicted of an offense 3 under this chapter to the extent the acquisition is the direct or 4 indirect result of the convicted person having committed the offense; 5 and
  - (b) Any property acquired through the traceable proceeds of property described in (a) of this subsection.
- 8 (2) A seizure and forfeiture of property authorized under this 9 section shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of RCW 10 7.68.320.
