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- 5 On page 4, after line 2, insert the following:
- 6 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. A new section is added to chapter 71.09 RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 A treatment provider, whether or not he or she is employed or
- 9 approved by the department of social and health services under section
- 10 5(1) of this act or otherwise certified, may not perform or provide
- 11 treatment of sexually violent predators under section 5 of this act if
- 12 the treatment provider has been:
- 13 (1) Convicted of a sex offense, as defined in RCW 9.94A.030;
- 14 (2) Convicted in any other jurisdiction of an offense that under
- 15 the laws of this state would be classified as a sex offense as defined
- 16 in RCW 9.94A.030; or
- 17 (3) Suspended or otherwise restricted from practicing any health
- 18 care profession by competent authority in any state, federal, or
- 19 foreign jurisdiction.
- 20 **Sec. 7.** RCW 18.155.070 and 1990 c 3 s 807 are each amended to read
- 21 as follows:
- 22 (1) The department shall issue a certificate to any applicant who
- 23 meets the following requirements:
- (((1))) (a) Successful completion of an educational program
- 25 approved by the secretary or successful completion of alternate
- 26 training which meets the criteria of the secretary;
- $((\frac{2}{2}))$ (b) Successful completion of any experience requirement
- 28 established by the secretary;
- 29 $((\frac{3}{2}))$ (c) Successful completion of an examination administered or
- 30 approved by the secretary;
- 31 $((\frac{4}{1}))$ (d) Not having engaged in unprofessional conduct or being
- 32 unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety as a result of a
- 33 physical or mental impairment;

- 1 (((+5))) (e) Other requirements as may be established by the 2 secretary that impact the competence of the sex offender treatment
- 3 provider.
- 4 (2) The department may not issue a certificate to any applicant who 5 has been:
- 6 (a) Convicted of a sex offense, as defined in RCW 9.94A.030;
- 7 (b) Convicted in any other jurisdiction of an offense that under
- 8 the laws of this state would be classified as a sex offense as defined
- 9 <u>in RCW 9.94A.030; or</u>
- 10 (c) Suspended or otherwise restricted from practicing any health
- 11 care profession by competent authority in any state, federal, or
- 12 <u>foreign jurisdiction.</u>"
- 13 Correct the title.

EFFECT: Prohibits a treatment provider, whether certified or not, from providing treatment to sexually violent predators who are in an LRA if the treatment provider has been convicted of a sex offense or been suspended or restricted from practicing any health care profession in any jurisdiction. State certification requirements would prohibit the applicant from being convicted of a sex offense or been suspended or restricted from practicing any health care profession in any jurisdiction.

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
