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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "**Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.410.010 and 1992 c 159 s 3 and 1992 c 60 s 2 are
8 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

9 (1) The state board of education shall establish, publish, and
10 enforce rules ((and regulations)) determining eligibility for and
11 certification of personnel employed in the common schools of this
12 state, including certification for emergency or temporary, substitute
13 or provisional duty and under such certificates or permits as the board
14 shall deem proper or as otherwise prescribed by law((-)) subject to the
15 following conditions:

16 (a) The rules shall require that the initial application for
17 certification shall require a record check of the applicant through the
18 Washington state patrol criminal identification system and through the
19 federal bureau of investigation at the applicant's expense. The record
20 check shall include a fingerprint check using a complete Washington
21 state criminal identification fingerprint card. The superintendent of
22 public instruction may waive the record check for any applicant who has
23 had a record check within the two years before application.

24 (b) The rules shall permit a holder of a lapsed certificate who has
25 separated from service with a school district or approved private
26 school located in the state of Washington to be employed on a
27 conditional basis for a maximum of two years by a school district or
28 approved private school under the following conditions:

29 (i) The holder's certificate has not been suspended or revoked;

30 (ii) The holder has successfully completed state-mandated
31 background checks;

32 (iii) The holder must complete any certificate renewal requirements
33 established by the state board of education within two years of initial
34 reemployment, and must develop and file with the employer a mutually
35 agreed upon written plan for achieving the requirements within the
36 allotted time; and

1 (iv) If hired by a school district, the holder shall be employed
2 under a one-year provisional contract that may be renewed no more than
3 once. The holder must make satisfactory progress toward the
4 achievement of the certificate renewal requirements before the
5 provisional contract may be renewed.

6 (2) In establishing rules pertaining to the qualifications of
7 instructors of American sign language the state board shall consult
8 with the national association of the deaf, "sign instructors guidance
9 network" (s.i.g.n.), and the Washington state association of the deaf
10 for evaluation and certification of sign language instructors.

11 (3) The superintendent of public instruction shall act as the
12 administrator of any such rules (~~(and regulations)~~) and have the power
13 to issue any certificates or permits and revoke the same in accordance
14 with board rules (~~(and regulations)~~)."

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18 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "certificates;" strike the
19 remainder of the title and insert "and reenacting and amending RCW
20 28A.410.010."

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
