5 On page 18, line 4, increase the general fund--state appropriation
6 for fiscal year 2003 by \$421,500

7 Correct the total accordingly

8 On page 23, after line 10, insert the following:

9 "(23) \$91,500 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
10 year 2002 and \$91,500 of the general fund-state appropriation for
11 fiscal year 2003 are provided solely for services related to the
12 foreign representative contract for Japan.

13 (24) \$81,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
14 year 2002 and \$81,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for
15 fiscal year 2003 are provided solely for business finance and loan
16 programs.

17 (25) \$150,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
18 year 2002 is provided solely for the quick sites initiative program.

19 (26) \$120,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
20 year 2002 and \$120,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for
21 fiscal year 2003 are provided solely for operating a business
22 information hotline.

23 (27) \$29,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
24 year 2002 and \$29,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for
25 fiscal year 2003 are provided solely for travel expenses associated
26 with the office of trade and economic development's provision of
27 outreach and technical assistance services to businesses and local
28 economic development associations.

29 (28) \$100,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal
30 year 2002 and \$100,000 of the general fund-state appropriation for
31 fiscal year 2003 are provided solely for information technology
32 enhancements designed to improve the delivery of agency services to
33 customers."

EFFECT: Provides funding in CTED's budget for the following items: the Japan business assistance office, business and finance loan programs, the quick sites initiative program, a business information hotline, travel costs associated with provision of outreach and technical services to businesses, and information technology improvements designed to improve the delivery of services to CTED's customers.

FISCAL IMPACT: Increases General Fund-State by \$993,000
