8 each amended to read as follows:

9 (1) (~~Every person who shall~~) (a) A person is guilty of taking a
10 motor vehicle without permission in the first degree if he or she,
11 without the permission of the owner or person entitled to possession,
12 intentionally takes or drives away an automobile or motor vehicle,
13 whether propelled by steam, electricity, or internal combustion engine,
14 that is the property of another, and he or she:

15 (i) Alters the motor vehicle for the purpose of changing its
16 appearance or primary identification, including obscuring, removing, or
17 changing the manufacturer's serial number or the vehicle identification
18 number plates;

19 (ii) Removes, or participates in the removal of, parts from the
20 motor vehicle with the intent to sell the parts;

21 (iii) Exports, or attempts to export, the motor vehicle across
22 state lines or out of the United States for profit;

23 (iv) Intends to sell the motor vehicle; or

24 (v) Is engaged in a conspiracy and the central object of the
25 conspiratorial agreement is the theft of motor vehicles for sale to
26 others for profit.

27 (b) Taking a motor vehicle without permission in the first degree
28 is a class B felony.

29 (2)(a) A person is guilty of taking a motor vehicle without
30 permission in the second degree if he or she, without the permission
31 of the owner or person entitled to (~~the~~) possession (~~thereof~~),
32 intentionally takes or drives away any automobile or motor vehicle,
33 whether propelled by steam, electricity, or internal combustion engine,
34 that is the property of another, (~~shall be deemed guilty of a felony,~~
35 and every person)) or he or she voluntarily (~~riding~~) rides in or upon
36 (~~said~~) the automobile or motor vehicle with knowledge of the fact

1 that the ((same)) automobile or motor vehicle was unlawfully taken
2 ((shall be equally guilty with the person taking or driving said
3 automobile or motor vehicle and shall be deemed guilty of taking a
4 motor vehicle without permission)).

5 ((+2)) (b) Taking a motor vehicle without permission in the second
6 degree is a class C felony.
