19 aquatic animal species, and allow their release into state waters
20 pursuant to rule of the commission: pacific oyster (*Crassostrea*
21 *gigas*), kumamoto oyster (*Crassostrea sikamea*), European flat oyster
22 (*Ostrea edulis*), eastern oyster (*Crassostrea virginica*), manila clam
23 (*Tapes philippinarum*), blue mussel (*Mytilus galloprovincialis*), and
24 suminoe oyster (*Crassostrea ariankensis*)"

EFFECT: Requires the Fish and Wildlife Commission to designate certain commercial shellfish species as regulated aquatic species.

11 health based on the presence of a native aquatic species."

EFFECT: Allows the Fish and Wildlife Commission, upon the recommendation of the director, to develop a work plan to eradicate native aquatic species that threaten human health. Priority is given to water bodies that have been classified by the Department of Health as a threat to human health based on the presence of a native aquatic species.
