- 20 dollars worth of products; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Canadian customers have expressed the desire to purchase
- high-quality aquacultural products from Washington state producers; and 22
- 23 WHEREAS, Many customers in the United States currently purchase
- 24 aquacultural products from Canada; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Increased freedom to engage in the commercial trade of
- 26 upland aquacultural products between the United States and Canada will
- 27 only help our two nations grow more prosperous;
- THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the 28
- government of the United States emphasize the importance of the free 29
- and fair trade of upland aquacultural products in its relations with 30
- 31 the government of Canada.
