**Background:** Over the years, various statutes have been amended without regard to the effect of those amendments in other statutes. These amendments have caused some technical and confusing situations.

**Summary of Bill:** Technical amendments are made to correct outdated references and double amendments all under Titles 29, 34, 42, 46, 47, and 82.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.

**Testimony For:** Outdated references were corrected. There was no change in the law. It makes the RCW's easier to use.
