1 AN ACT Relating to the use of gasoline additives; adding a new
2 section to chapter 19.112 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 19.112 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) Methyl tertiary-butyl ether may not be intentionally added to
7 any gasoline, motor fuel, or clean fuel produced for sale or use in the
8 state of Washington after December 31, 2003, and in no event may methyl
9 tertiary-butyl ether be present in gasoline above six-tenths of one
10 percent by volume.

11 (2) A violation of this section is a misdemeanor.
