- 1 AN ACT Relating to allowing school districts to provide voters
- 2 adequate information regarding school levy elections; and amending
- 3 RCW 42.17.130.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17.130 and 1979 ex.s. c 265 s 2 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 No elective official nor any employee of his office nor any
- 8 person appointed to or employed by any public office or agency may
- 9 use or authorize the use of any of the facilities of a public
- 10 office or agency, directly or indirectly, for the purpose of
- 11 assisting a campaign for election of any person to any office or
- 12 for the promotion of or opposition to any ballot proposition.
- 13 Facilities of public office or agency include, but are not limited
- 14 to, use of stationery, postage, machines, and equipment, use of
- 15 employees of the office or agency during working hours, vehicles,
- 16 office space, publications of the office or agency, and clientele
- 17 lists of persons served by the office or agency: PROVIDED, That the

- 1 foregoing provisions of this section shall not apply to the 2 following activities:
- 3 (1) Action taken at an open public meeting by members of an 4 elected legislative body to express a collective decision, or to
- 5 actually vote upon a motion, proposal, resolution, order, or
- 6 ordinance, or to support or oppose a ballot proposition so long as
- 7 (a) any required notice of the meeting includes the title and
- 8 number of the ballot proposition, and (b) members of the
- 9 legislative body or members of the public are afforded an
- 10 approximately equal opportunity for the expression of an opposing
- 11 view;
- 12 (2) A statement by an elected official in support of or in
- 13 opposition to any ballot proposition at an open press conference
- 14 or in response to a specific inquiry;
- 15 (3) <u>Publications of a school district providing factual</u>
- 16 <u>information related to school levy elections;</u>
- 17 (4) Activities which are part of the normal and regular conduct
- 18 of the office or agency.
