- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.45 RCW 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Exchanges and sales of real estate are exempt from tax under this 9 chapter if the following conditions are met:
- 10 (1) The exchange consists of a transfer of privately owned real 11 estate for land administered by the United States secretary of 12 agriculture or secretary of the interior, or both; and
- (2) The values of the exchanged parcels are equal, or if not equal, have been equalized in a manner provided by the act of congress
- 15 authorizing the exchange; or
- 16 (3) The sale is to an agency of the United States administered by
- 17 the secretary of agriculture or secretary of interior, or to a
- 18 nonprofit nature conservancy corporation or association as defined in

- 1 restore, limit the future use of, or otherwise conserve the real estate
- 2 for public use or enjoyment.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 82.46 RCW
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 The exemption in section 1 of this act is for the state real estate
- 6 excise tax and does not extend to taxes imposed under this chapter.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 9 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 10 immediately.
