- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21C RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The legislature finds that the flood plains of the state's rivers
- 8 are a part of the river system and have a significant function, in
- 9 respect to channel movement and fish habitat, which is especially
- 10 important in light of the listings and potential listings of fish as
- 11 threatened or endangered under the federal endangered species act. The

- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Except for metals mining and milling operations subject to RCW
- 6 43.21C.039, and notwithstanding any provision in RCW 43.21C.030 and
- 7 43.21C.031 to the contrary, an environmental impact statement shall be
- 8 prepared for any new or expanded public or private surface mine when
- 9 all or part of the proposed mine falls within a flood plain as defined
- 10 in WAC 173-22-030.
- 11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 78.44 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 Except for metals mining and milling operations subject to RCW
- 14 78.56.050, an environmental impact statement must be prepared for any
- 15 new or expanded public or private surface mine when all or part of the
- 16 proposed mine falls within a flood plain as defined in WAC 173-22-030.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 90.58 RCW
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 Surface mining is prohibited in areas designated as conservancy in
- 20 local shoreline management plans.
