- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- 7 (b) Taking a motor vehicle without permission in the first degree 8 is a class B felony.
- 9 (2)(a) A person is guilty of taking a motor vehicle without
- 10 permission in the second degree if he or she, without the permission
- 11 of the owner or person entitled to ((the)) possession ((thereof)),
- 12 intentionally takes or drives away any automobile or motor vehicle,

- 3rd and subsequent escape or attempted escape during 12-month period - 12 weeks confinement
- 16 If the court finds that a respondent has violated terms of an order, 17 it may impose a penalty of up to 30 days of confinement.
