- 1 AN ACT Relating to law libraries; adding a new section to chapter
- 2 27.24 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that there may be
- 5 increased efficiencies in the provision of law library services through
- 6 the use of available online electronic research tools.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 27.24 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (1) The state library shall investigate the possibility of
- 10 contracting with a vendor or vendors of online electronic legal
- 11 research services for the provision of such services statewide through
- 12 the county law library system.
- 13 (2) If the state library determines that such a contract would be
- 14 an improvement in the efficiency of the delivery of law library
- 15 services in the counties, after June 30, 2002, the state library may
- 16 enter into such a contract. If the state library enters into a
- 17 contract, the state library shall provide for the availability of an
- 18 online electronic research system at any county law library that

- chooses to contract with the state library for such services. Any such system shall allow for librarians and patrons to use the research 2 services either at the library facility or through electronic 3 4 connection with the library.
- 5 (3) As part of a contract with a county law library, the state library may charge a fee to any county law library that chooses to use the system made available by the state library. A county law library 8 may charge a fee to any patron for the use of the system.
