- 1 AN ACT Relating to nonelected judicial officers and commissioners;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 2.28 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes the need for, and 5 the benefits that accrue from, using appointed and nonelected judicial 6 officers and commissioners to help facilitate the judicial process and expedite the resolution of disputes. The legislature also recognizes that elected judicial officers are chosen by the voters and are 8 9 directly accountable to the citizens who put them in office. Judicial 10 officers and commissioners who serve the public should ultimately give
- the people at large the opportunity to judge their abilities and 11
- 12 competence by running for judicial office.
- 13 Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 2.28 RCW NEW SECTION. 14 to read as follows:
- (1) Appointed and nonelected judicial officers and commissioners 15
- 16 serving in the municipal courts, district courts, and superior courts
- of this state must run for election in order to continue to serve as a 17
- judicial officer in the courts of this state. 18

- 1 (2) A judicial officer or commissioner of the municipal, district, 2 or superior courts who is serving under appointment, rather than by 3 election, must run for election in order to continue to serve if the 4 judicial officer or commissioner has worked:
- 5 (a) More than twenty-four hours per week for any consecutive 6 twelve-week period;

- (b) More than twenty-four hours per week for eight weeks during any twenty-four week period;
 - (c) More than two hundred forty hours during any one-year period.
- 10 (3) For purposes of this section, hours worked during any period of 11 time shall be equal to the hours the appointed and nonelected judicial 12 officer or commissioner claimed for purposes of being paid and for 13 which the judicial officer or commissioner was paid.
