- 1 AN ACT Relating to clarifying "voluntarily fails" for water rights
- 2 relinquishment purposes; adding a new section to chapter 90.14 RCW; and
- 3 declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.14 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- For the purposes of RCW 90.14.140 through 90.14.180, unless the
- 8 context clearly requires otherwise, "voluntarily fails" means the
- 9 nonuse of all or a portion of the water by the owner of the water
- 10 right, where the nonuse occurs as a result of factors within the
- 11 control of the water user. A failure to use all or a portion of a
- 12 water right for irrigation use is involuntary when the water needed for
- 13 irrigation use under the right is reduced as a result of:
- 14 (1) Varying weather conditions including but not limited to
- 15 precipitation and temperature, so long as the water user's diversion
- 16 and delivery facilities are maintained in good operating condition
- 17 consistent with the beneficial use of the full amount of the water
- 18 right. The burden is on the water user to prove that the weather

- 1 conditions are significantly different from average conditions such 2 that they resulted in the reduction of water use;
- 3 (2) The temporary presence of return flows used in lieu of water 4 from the primary source of water supply under the right if the return 5 flows are measured or reliably estimated using a scientific methodology 6 accepted as reliable by the director of the department of ecology; or 7 (3) Crop rotation.
- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its 9 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the 10 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other 11 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately.
