- 1 AN ACT Relating to all terrain vehicles; and amending RCW
- 2 46.10.010.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.10.010 and 1979 ex.s. c 182 s 1 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 As used in this chapter the words and phrases in this section shall
- 7 have the designated meanings unless a different meaning is expressly
- 8 provided or the context otherwise clearly indicated.
- 9 (1) "Person" shall mean any individual, firm, partnership, 10 association, or corporation.
- 11 (2) "Snowmobile" shall mean any self-propelled vehicle capable of
- 12 traveling over snow or ice, which utilizes as its means of propulsion
- 13 an endless belt tread, or cleats, or any combination of these or other
- 14 similar means of contact with the surface upon which it is operated,
- 15 and which is steered wholly or in part by skis or sled type runners,
- 16 and which is not otherwise registered as, or subject to the motor
- 17 vehicle excise tax in the state of Washington.
- 18 (3) "All terrain vehicle" shall mean any self-propelled vehicle
- 19 other than a snowmobile, capable of cross-country travel on or

- 1 immediately over land, water, snow, ice, marsh, swampland, and other
- 2 natural terrain, including, but not limited to, nonhighway vehicles
- 3 defined in RCW 46.09.020, four-wheel vehicles, amphibious vehicles,
- 4 ground effect or air cushion vehicles, and any other means of land
- 5 transportation deriving motive power from any source other than muscle
- 6 or wind; except any vehicle designed primarily for travel on, over, or
- 7 in the water, farm vehicles, or any military or law enforcement
- 8 vehicles.
- 9 (4) "Owner" shall mean the person, other than a lienholder, having
- 10 the property in or title to a snowmobile or all terrain vehicle, and
- 11 entitled to the use or possession thereof.
- 12 (5) "Operator" means each person who operates, or is in physical
- 13 control of, any snowmobile or all terrain vehicle.
- 14 (6) "Public roadway" shall mean the entire width of the right of
- 15 way of any road or street designed and ordinarily used for travel or
- 16 parking of motor vehicles, which is controlled by a public authority
- 17 other than the Washington state department of transportation, and which
- 18 is open as a matter of right to the general public for ordinary
- 19 vehicular traffic.
- 20 (7) "Highways" shall mean the entire width of the right of way of
- 21 all primary and secondary state highways, including all portions of the
- 22 interstate highway system.
- 23 (8) "Dealer" means a person, partnership, association, or
- 24 corporation engaged in the business of selling snowmobiles or all
- 25 terrain vehicles at wholesale or retail in this state.
- 26 (9) "Department" shall mean the department of licensing.
- 27 (10) "Director" shall mean the director of the department of
- 28 licensing.
- 29 (11) "Commission" shall mean the Washington state parks and
- 30 recreation commission.
- 31 (12) "Hunt" shall mean any effort to kill, injure, capture, or
- 32 disturb a wild animal or wild bird.
- 33 (13) "Committee" means the Washington state parks and recreation
- 34 commission snowmobile advisory committee.
